Despite the economic slowdown, all constituent colleges of SOA (Siksha O Anusandhan) University — deemed university declared under U/S 3 of UGC Act, 1956 — have excelled in the campus placement drive recently held by different national players and MNCs. This year, the varsity has achieved an all-time record in campus placement since past 10 years. The flagship constituent college of SOA University ITER, a name synonym to engineering education in Orissa, has the highest

placement record with 478 students of 2010 pass-out batch having been placed in just 15 days through campus recruitment drive conducted on the ITER campus. Infosys has recruited the highest number of 198 students (highest number recruited from any campus so far), while TCS has taken 171 candidates followed by Wipro — 71, Adani Group — 16, Vedanta — 13 and Zensar Technologies — 9. Almost all the students of Computer Science and IT have already been recruited by different companies. Many more companies have already given their consent to visit ITER campus in con-
